Tinkertown Museum opens for its 22nd season on April 1, 2005. Come visit and see the life work of Ross Ward, in one of New Mexico's most renowned folk art environments. See more than 30 years of woodcarvings and collecting, including an animated miniature 1880's Western Town and Circus and glass bottle house. You will experience a unique and unusual step backwards into time when your trip to the Sandia Mountains includes a stroll down the main street of "Tinkertown". Tinkertown is located on the Turquoise Trail National Scenic Byway (www.turquoisetrail.org) on the way to Sandia Crest. Take I-40 20 minutes east of Albuquerque to exist 175. Head north on NM 14 six miles to NM 536, then left 1.5 miles. The Museum is open every day from 9:00am-6:00pm April 1st to November 1.
